

Application by New Resident to Vote for President and Vice President 52 USC § 10502, NRS 298.259, and NAC 298.010

A new resident of Nevada who moved to this state less than 30 days before the upcoming election may use this form to apply for a ballot to vote for the offices of President and Vice President only. This is permitted under Nevada Revised Statute 298.259 and Nevada Administrative Code 298.010, provided that you are otherwise qualified to vote in another state but do not yet meet Nevada's voter residency requirements.

Please note: This application may be used solely to obtain a ballot that permits voting for the offices of President and Vice President <u>only</u>. To become a registered voter in Nevada, you must complete a separate application upon meeting the residency requirements of this state.

Voting may occur only in the office of the County Clerk or Registrar of Voters during regular working
