5.	Interfering with the conduct of voting.
: I fur	ther acknowledge that I may be removed from the polling place by the county or city clerk
for violatin	ng any provisions of title 24 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) or any of the provisions
described	herein.
: The	county or city clerk may:
a.	Limit the number of persons in the polling place who are observing the conduct of
	voting for reasons of public safety or to protect voter privacy or maintain order.
b.	Remove from a polling place a person observing the conduct of voting pursuant to this
	section for violating any provision of title 24 of NRS or any of the provisions described
	herein.
: Ар	erson observing the conduct of voting at a polling place must comply with the same
requireme	nts that apply to members of the general public, including the requirements of NRS
293.274, 2	293.305, 293.730, 293C.269 and 293C.297.
: A pe	erson observing the conduct of voting at a polling place may remain in the designated
area in the	e polling place after the polls close so as to observe the closing of the polling place. The
person sh	all not interfere with the closing of the polling place.
