

## Polling Locations on Tribal Lands - NRS 293.2733 and NRS 293.3572

NRS 293.2733 and NRS 293.3572 require City and County Clerks to provide a polling place within the boundaries of an Indian reservation or colony during a Presidential Preference Primary, Primary, or General Election. Tribes may also choose to opt-out of having a polling place or dropbox by notifying the County Clerk. To request or decline a polling place, please complete this form and submit it to the County Clerk or Registrar of Voters in your county.

Under state law, the county or city clerk is responsible for recruiting poll workers for polling places located within the boundaries of an Indian reservation or colony unless the tribe formally declines this assistance. The clerk is also responsible for providing training on the use of mechanical voting systems either virtually or in-person on the reservation.

**NOTE:** This form only needs to be completed once, unless changes are required. The Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) is during Presidential Election Cycles only.



The Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) is a statewide election where registered voters in Nevada choose their preferred candidate for President.
