

How To Guide - FDS Reports

Published by the Office of the Nevada Secretary of State

FDS Reports - Who is required to file?

A Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) is required to be filed with the Secretary of State by all state and local Elected officials and Appointed public officers by January 15 of each year they are in office. Failure to file such a form may result in a civil penalty. [NRS 281.581(3)].

Judges and judicial candidates are required to file a FDS with the Administrative Office of the Court (AOC).

There are three types of Financial Disclosure Statements:

- Annual
- Appointment
- Candidate

ANNUAL FDS

Campaign Finance Reporting Requirements

- The ANNUAL FDS is due not later than January 15th and covers the preceding calendar year (NRS 281.559(1)(b)
 & NRS 281.561(1)(b). This must be filed by the following public officers:
- All public officers holding an elected office, regardless of salary
- All public officers holding a non-elected office and whose annual salary is \$6,000 or more
- All state legislators

APPOINTMENT FDS

Campaign Finance Reporting Requirements

- The APPOINTMENT FDS is due not later than thirty (30) days after the public officer's date of appointment (NRS 281.559(1)(a). This must be filed by the following public officers:
- All public officers appointed to an elected office who are entitled to receive \$6,000 or more annually
- All appointments to the state Legislature
- All public officers appointed to fill the unexpired term of an elected or appointed public officer

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CANDIDATE FDS

Campaign Finance Reporting Requirements

- The CANDIDATE FDS is due not later than ten (10) days after the end of candidate filing and covers the preceding calendar year plus January 1 of the current year through the last date of candidate filing (NRS 281.561(1)(a). This must be filed by the following public officers:
- All candidates seeking public office who are entitled to receive \$6,000 or more annually
- All candidates for the office of state Legislator
- All public officers previously elected to the office they are serving (e.g. incumbents) regardless of salary




How to File an FDS Report

- 1. Access the Secretary of State's website at: www.nvsos.gov
- 2. Select the Campaign Finance blue button (left side of screen)
- 3. You will be directed to the "AURORA Campaign Finance Disclosure" page
- 4. Click on: Login to File Reports
- 5. Enter your email and password
- 6. Click on "File A Report" blue button and on the next page click "Financial Disclosure Statement"
- 7. A listing will appear. Click the button next to the FDS report you need to file (nothing happens so scroll down on the page)
- 8. Make sure your contact information is correct. Answer two mandatory questions (length of residence and length of residence in district) and click Save and Proceed.
- 9. This will bring up the report. Follow prompts to file.





Section one of the FDS report is the most important section to input public officer information and to keep it current.

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Sections 5, 6, & 7 of FDS

SECTION 5 (Meetings, Events, Trips): List all educational or informational meetings, events or trips you or a member of your household have taken during the filling period including (a) the purpose and location of the meeting, event or trip and the name of the organization conducting, sponsoring, hosting or requesting the meeting, event or trip; (b) the identity of each interested person providing anything of value to you or a member of your household to undertake or attend the meeting, event or trip; and (c) the aggregate value of everything provided by those interested persons to you or a member of your household to undertake or attend the meeting, event or trip [NRS 281.571 (5)]. Please note this information is only required for meetings, events or trips taken after December 31, 2015. **Help?**

Penalties

Penalty schedule as provided in NRS 281.581:

- If the report is filed 1-10 days late, \$25 for each day the report is late.
- If the report is filed 11-20 days late, \$50 for each day the report is late.
- If the report is filed 21-30 days late, \$100 for each day the report is late.
- If the report is filed 31-45 days late, \$250 for each day the report is late.
- If the report is filed more than 46 days late, the maximum violation is \$2,000.
- A Waiver Request will be sent to candidate or appointee. When the Secretary of State receives a reply stating why they were late in filing, the fees will be waived. The official will receive a Waiver Granted email.
